The fellowship program in Gynecologic Endoscopic Surgery at St. Luke's-Roosevelt Hospital Center is a one-year comprehensive program incorporating clinical, research and educational activities. The fellow will acquire skills in advanced hysteroscopic and laparoscopic procedures for benign conditions like fibroids, adnexal mass, endometriosis, DUB, various urogynecologic procedures, etc. A unique feature of this program is not only the incorporation of training in robotics as it applies to specific gynecologic procedures but due to the nature of the practice, the fellow will have exposure to certain gynecological malignancies and opportunity to assist in laparoscopic staging and radical surgery for gynecologic malignancies.
