The teaching facility of the fellowship program at Baylor College of Medicine will be at St. Luke's Episcopal Hospital. The program will have a full range of laparoscopic procedures, with emphasis on hysteroscopy, with extensive office-based procedure experience in diagnostic hysteroscopy, as well as hysteroscopic sterilization and endometrial ablation. The fellow will have access to robotic surgery, operate with other surgeons in general surgery, gynecologic oncology, colorectal surgery and urology affiliated with the fellowship program, review patient information to obtain an independent assessment, have research time, participate in clinical research and present at least one paper per year at a national meeting and submit an article to a peer-reviewed journal.
