Program Description

The fellowship in Advanced Gynecologic Endoscopic Surgery at the University in Louisville, Kentucky is a two-year academic program. In 2001, we were initiated into the approved SRS fellowship program sponsored by the AAGL/SRS. We are one of the few academic centers in the country that offers a fellowship program in Minimally Invasive Gynecologic Surgery. We perform all of the surgical procedures in minimally invasive gynecology, infertility and urogynecology. Our GYN Oncology division performs robotic oncologic surgery.

The program not only incorporates the fellow in the university setting where they are involved with the teaching of residents, but also involves alternating in the operating room with two very busy physicians in private practices: Dr. Jonathan Reinstine with Associates in OB/GYN and Dr. Lori Warren with Women First of Louisville. The entire gamut of endoscopic surgery will be experienced by the fellow including training in urogynecologic procedures and pelvic reconstruction.
